All leadership roles within the Sons of The American Legion are voluntary and pro bono. Please only volunteer if you are genuinely committed and can reliably contribute your time.

Within thirty days following the adjournment of the Department/Detachment Convention, the Detachment Commander shall appoint Committee/Commission Chairmen for the ensuing year, subject to the approval of the Detachment Executive Committee.

Chairmen should attend their respective National Committee/Commission meetings via Zoom; links will be provided by the National Chairmen.

Chairmen are expected to relay relevant information to Detachment leadership as necessary. Additionally, Chairmen must provide both a brief verbal report and a written report when called upon by the Detachment Commander at the Mid-Winter Conference and the Detachment Convention.

Chairmen should respond to all correspondence within 24 hours, maintaining professional etiquette and respecting the sender's time.
